The programme without the Eucharistic Celebration

15h00 – 15h45: Universal Prayer – “The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy”

The prayer includes:

- reciting the rosary
- 3 scriptures’ reading and meditation
- 2 hymns
- prayer of individual intentions & universal prayers.
- Concluded by singing a hymn for Mother of Mercy: *Salve Regina*.

15h45 – 16h45: Optional activity, depending on one’s circumstance:

- Teaching or reflection of Today’s Gospel; or watching a religious film or based on teaching film, etc, and then...
- Individual sharing

16h45 – 17h10: Song of Praise and Worship to God, and prayers:

- Sing two hymns to God, followed by prayers of praising and worshipping to God
- Sing one hymn to the Holy Spirit, followed by *prayer in tongues*
- Discernment (in silence): Listen to God’s word in your heart and say it out to others
- Prayer over people who are in need of God’s grace (optional).

17h10 – 17h20: To end the prayer meeting:

- Sing a final hymn: Thanksgiving to God!
- Universal prayers: 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary & 1 Glory be to God
- Sing together: Shalom to everyone!

17h20 - Fellowship¹

- Sing two hymns to God, followed by prayers of praising and worshipping to God
- Sing one hymn to the Holy Spirit, followed by *prayer in tongues*
- Discernment (in silence): Listen to God’s word in your heart and say it out to others
- Sing a final hymn: Thanksgiving to God!
- Universal prayers: 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary & 1 Glory be to God
