Sharing-Teaching

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Let us bless the Lord for His Love and Mercy is endless and awesome! Alleluia!

My family and I are delighted to be with you all today - "Welcome everyone!" Brothers and sisters in Christ, I would like to thank you for your presence here today, and I thank God for this Prayer Group, for without His inspiration given to me, this Prayer Group would not exist. Let us give a big applaud to the Lord for this prayer Group! Amen!

Today, I would like to do a sharing about this prayer group and concerning my life with God. In short, I shall talk about how God call me to be His instrument to do His work of Love and Mercy, through which this Prayer Group has now become reality. I shall also talk about God's love and Mercy, God's Kingdom and His Commandments.

This Prayer Group is the first time hold in our home. I believe that you are here because you have answered the call from God through the leaflet, in which the leaflet itself is devised by me through God's inspiration. I received the call from God to form a prayer group about a little bit more than 3 months ago, on 9th January 2012. However, I did not answer His call at once as I have to put it into prayer and let the Lord guide me what to do it; I had nothing in my head to commence it. In my prayer I called unto the Lord to help me realise His will, I said to Him, "How can I do it, Lord? I am nothing! Show me what and how to do it?"

Despite, God is faithful, because He kept reminding me about forming a Prayer Group. As a result of my daily prayer, and the prayer together with my family i.e., reciting the rosary, one day...on the 9th March, 2012, I received His third call, in which it is mystically the same date when I received His first call, on 9th January 2012. The second call is on 28 January 2012. On 9th March 2012, I received a Word from God, which is very touching, and that inspired me so much. In fact, in my morning prayer at home, the Lord had given me a card; in the card it is written a small text of Psalm 119. I was struck by the word "promise"; therefore, I asked Him what it means. He answered me when I was at the Holy Mass in Pepinster on the same day; when I headed out from the church for home, the Lord answered it to me in my heart, "It's the Good News...: it is the Salvation that I promise." Several days later, in my morning prayer, the Lord asked me to spread His Word to everyone. Yes, truly, His Word gives me great joy and boldness to do it. Alleluia! Now, you can see the birth of this Prayer Group. I give thanks to the Almighty God! Amen!

Brothers and sisters in Christ, I also believe that you are here, as you want to discover who God really is and to build up your relationship with Him closer to your heart. God is always with us, as the scripture says in Matthew 18:20, "For two or three come together in my name, I am there with them." So when you pray or sing to God today, give your heart completely to God - He is the One that you want to praise, to thank and to glorify. He is the One that can heal you, change you and solve your problems. No man on earth can do any healing, and make miracles except God alone! (Act 4:30) All disciples, apostles, as well as prophets are the anointed servants of God who helps build up God's Kingdom through the teaching of His Son, Jesus Christ. These anointed people are blessed by God and they become the instruments of God to perform healing and miracles, for ONE COMMON PURPOSE to bring SALVATION to the world, and that the world can open their eyes to the Truth and God's Love; this discovery may lead the world to love God, who is the only God, our Creator and our Saviour. The scripture says in Isaiah 45:5-6, God says to the prophet Isaiah, "I am the LORD; there is no other god. I will give you the strength you need, although you do not know Me. I do this so that everyone from one end of the world to the other may know that I am the LORD,

and that there is no other god." Similarly, only God can redeem our sins, heal us and give us life again. Healing is in reference to Salvation. In Luke 4:18-19, Jesus says, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has chosen me to bring the Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set free the oppressed and announce that the time has come when the Lord will save His people." Whatever your intention is to be here, God understands what you are looking for. Just give your heart to Him, with sincerity; surrender yourself to Him, surrender all your sins, and that may the Holy Spirit come to heal you. At the end of this Prayer Group session, there will be a prayer over session, so if anyone wants to be prayed over, please do not hesitate to come forward in the centre, we will pray over you, and the Good Lord ALONE will heal you. Remember, only through "faith" one can be healed by God. Brothers and sisters in Christ, indeed, God loves you, and He wants to heal you!

As I said, I believe that you are here because you have answered the call from God. Each time you are present at this prayer group, I pray that may all of you receive a lot of blessing from the Almighty God.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, sharing your faith or experience with God helps others sees the Light of Christ and the treasures in His Kingdom. The treasures I mentioned here are peace, true happiness, healing, goodwill, and all the virtues that we need to live in this troubled world, such as patience, charity, humility, kindness, etc, and most importantly, LOVE! For this reason, I would encourage you to participate in the Sharing session later, because simply through sharing your faith or your experience with God with us, will help others in knowing God. All of us have our own liberty to share, to pray, to sing for GOD Alone! Focus to Jesus, He is in the centre of our meeting today; Jesus is the ONLY one our Good Shepherd (John 10:14-15). I also think that sharing could help us find great joy in the Lord: like a child, learning to discover how to get closer to her/his father or mother's way, by means of loving. Similarly, we, we are children of God (1 John 3:1); God the Father calls us to build up our relationship with Him through sharing with him, for example in our personal prayer to God, but also sharing with our brothers and sisters in Christ, in this prayer group. In doing so, then can we find deeper and meaningful love of God, through Jesus Christ who is our Saviour and Redeemer King. We should love one another through sharing; in 1 John 4:12b), the Scripture says,

"... if we love one another, God lives in union with us, and His love is made perfect in us."

God is Love (1 John 4:7-8); His love is unconditional (1 John 4:9-10). Since God is love, He shows us that He never abandons us despite our sinful nature. For God does not come to call righteous, but sinners (see Mark 2:17b). He promises Salvation is for all (see Romans 10). In Romans 10:13, the scripture says, 'Everyone who calls out to the Lord for help will be saved.' And in Romans 10:9-10, 'If you confess that Jesus is Lord and believe that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by our faith that we are put right with God; it is by our confession that we are saved.' I see God is merciful; He does not condemn us even our sins are like "scarlet". No matter who you are...in God's eyes, you are dear to Him. Speaking of religion, in human's perception, it is a very sensitive issue; for if one talks about it, it causes loads of chaotic, for example, what we have seen on TV since then. Despite diversity of religions, God calls the world to respect one another differences in worshipping Him alone. Hence, I see that human perception is in contrarily to God's view. In God's eyes, religions are merely a symbol; any religion that people practise in their prayer, is a way how to reach the Almighty God. But what sort of prayer that pleasing God? Most importantly, if we pray, there must be LOVE & HUMILITY in our heart, and that we pray in Spirit and in Truth; this type of prayer is pleasing God, for in prayer, God sees our heart: for instance, reflect about these questions: Do we pray with sincere heart? Do we pray humbly and with love? Does our prayer have a good intention? The other questions for your reflection are based on "LOVE", how do we love God? How do we serve God? How do we love and serve others in God's love? These questions lead us to understand the importance of obeying God's Word that is His Great Commandments. What are those? In Matthew 22:37, Jesus answered "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." And in Matthew 22:39, Jesus continued, "Love your neighbour as you love yourself." In fact, in the New Testament, Jesus re-emphasised the Commandments, which God first had handed it down to Moses on Mount Sinai (see Exodus 20; Exodus 34:27-28).

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, once again, we thank you with all our heart for your presence today. We pray so that the Flaming Love of the Lord, Jesus Christ, always remains in your hearts, and we hope that you come back next time with a lot of joy in the Lord. Most importantly is your presence here, and that you could find what you would like in the Kingdom of God. Do not go far away, as the Kingdom of God is in your heart! (Luke 12:34). The Love and Mercy of God is for all humanity...

Let us praise the Blessed Trinity: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit! Give thanks and glorify His Holy Name at any time and regardless of our situation in our daily life!

Let us also thank the Mother of the Saviour for Her Love and Mercy! For She leads us all to Her Son, and to the Father, and through Her constant prayers, interceding them to God, for us. AMEN!

Sharing-Teaching

Dear Brothers and sisters,

First of all, I thank you for your present here today at this prayer group. I am glad to see some new faces as well as former ones, above all, praise the LORD!

Today is the *Pentecost Sunday*. What does it mean, 'Pentecost Sunday'? Generally, it is the day where all Christian places of worship around the globe celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit from the Almighty God. It is celebrated annually in honour the third person in the Divine Trinity – the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In our Catholic places of worship, like in churches, we celebrate this religious day at Sunday Mass, hence it is called Pentecost Sunday.

In view of the Pentecost Sunday, today, I would like to speak about the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and later I will share with you a bit, concerning my experience with God after receiving His Spirit.

I believe many people do not recognise who the Holy Spirit is, not only non-Christians, but baptised Christians too. Nowadays, our societies have gone too far away from believing and practising the Christian faith due to so many world influences. Clearly, we live in an era where we can find all comfort, gastronomic food on our table, luxurious holidays, and good technology and so on. All these, can draw people to be selfish, self-indulgent and pride when they idolise them, rather than to remember that the gifts are from God? Do we use this materialistic world according to God's Will? Do we thank Him for both, good and bad things we have had? Pride, Selfishness, and self-indulgent are human primary weaknesses, in which if we do not conscious to get them rid off, sooner and later these mere human-attitudes leads to a pitfall, that is, mortal sins. Sins separate us from God, and sins do not help us to see the Light of Christ. However, God is Love and God is Merciful, as He never abandons us, poor sinners, instead He wants us to come closer and closer to Him every moment of our life. For this reason, God first descended to the world in the form of a man, Jesus Christ, His only Son, born of a humble Virgin, named Mary. All God's plan is a mystery, which aimed at saving us to Heaven. Yet, when Jesus was in the world, still, many do not know Him or rejected Him; He cruelly suffered and died on the Cross, for us. As Jesus says, "The greatest love a person can have for his friends is to give his life for them." (John 15:13) God loves us and He suffered for us to have our sins redeemed through our faith in Jesus Christ. In Roman 5:6-8, the Scripture says, "For when we were still helpless, Christ died for the wicked at the time that God chose. It is a difficult thing for someone to die for a righteous person. it may even be that someone might dare to die for a good person. BUT God has shown us how much HE LOVES US - it was while we were still sinners that Christ died for us!" In fact, through this amazing mystery, is the way how God can reach us, reconcile with us and the process of conversion heart, bring us back to know Him and to Love Him more and more. That is the Father's project, is to bring us to the Light of Christ, through which gives us Life Eternal. The Blessed Virgin Mary is the gift for all humanity as She is the most unique woman chosen by God to helps us come closer to Him, who is our Creator. And She is the first Servant of God who receives the Holy Spirit, and that God's Word was made flesh in Her womb, whose Son is named as Jesus - the Messiah!

As I did say early on, that the Holy Spirit is the third Person in the Divine Trinity. The three Persons are ONE. Therefore, there is only ONE God! Hence, the Holy Spirit is God, as whatever He says through Jesus, and through God's anointed Servants, such as, through the preaching the Good News, is from God. In other words, none of the words that come out from a preacher or a prophet are theirs, but God's. Before Jesus Christ ascending into Heaven and sitting at the right hand of God the Father, He said to His disciples that He has to return to His Father as how He was sent to the world by His Father. However, He never abandons us,

and says, "I have much more to tell you, but now it would be too much to you to bear. When, however, the Spirit comes, who reveals the truth about God, He will lead you into all the truth. He will not speak on His own authority, but He will tell you of things to come. He will give me glory, because he will take what I say and tell it to you. All that My Father has is mine; that is why I said that the Spirit will take what I give Him and tell it to you." (John 16:12-15)

Brothers and sisters in Christ, do not be afraid of welcoming and receiving the Holy Spirit in your Life. The Holy Spirit is God, our Advocate, who is sent to us by God the Father. In the same way, Jesus in person was with us 2000 years ago. And now, the Spirit of God is with us - Emmanuel, God is with us!

If anyone of you would like to be prayed over, do not hesitate to come forward in the centre after this session later. In order to receive God's grace, you just have to surrender yourself to God. I will bless you with blessed oil and we all pray over you, and God will do the rest... Give your heart to God for purification.

I would like to tell you a "Love Story" between me and God. I was 15 years old when I first fell in Love with God. It was the day when I received the Holy Spirit in me. At that time, I was praying in tongue. I was in a congregation of a Charismatic Renewal prayer group in Tawau, Malaysia. What I was doing during the prayer, is that, I simply surrender all my being to God...And called God to wholly cleanse me and to entirely take control of my being. I asked Him only to replace who I am with His LOVE. Yes, I did! God listened to me, I was renewed. When the Holy Spirit was in me at that time, I felt like the "electricity" went through my body, from my head to my feet. My hands became firm and shaken. My heart was overjoyed and tears of joy were rolling down my cheeks - I was sensing the Power of Love of God...It is indescribable!! When I gained my consciousness, I was back to normal state. At that moment, I was feeling very happy (more than that!). I felt I am not who I was before. From then onwards, I started participating actively in churches activities...My life is ... for the Lord, to serve Him as much as I can. I even tried to evangelise about my faith to my friends and pen-pals, one of my pen-pals was Thierry - that's how we know each other, and it is because our faith in The Lord that leads us together until now, despite of hardships in many things, family life and so on. My faith teaches me not to be afraid of suffering, instead humbly welcoming it with thanksgiving to God, as suffering is a way of purification. For God says in John 16:33a, "The world will make you suffer. But be brave! I have defeated the world!" In 1 Peter 3:14, the Scripture says, "Even if you should suffer for doing what is right, how happy you are! Do not be afraid of anyone, and do not worry. What does "Do not worry" here means? For example, in my spiritual life, I should not worry of so many things...as God is my providence, and He is my ONLY security. At times, suffering is a test from God, so that we will not walk in the wrong path, but the right path - God is our Loving Father, who always keeps an eye on us. Do you know that? As the scripture says in Exodus 20: 20, "Don't be afraid; God has only come to test you and make you keep on obeying Him, so that you will not be sin." God is like a Refiner's Fire, He refines silver, and tests them as gold is tested. The silver and gold are us. God tests our faith every day...do you know that? In Zechariah 13:9, God says, "I will purify... as silver is purified by fire. I will test...as gold is tested." Hence, when we welcome the Holy Spirit into our life, He purifies us, and all through our life on earth God tests our faith, and the Holy Spirit that remains in us guides us to walk in the right path.

In fact, for the second time, I received the Holy Spirit, when I was attending a prayer for healing session in London. It was so awesome! God never abandons me, despite my past weaknesses. God never ever abandon us, he is faithful forever... For me, He is my Good Shepherd now and forever. The Lord's presence in my life is why I live as I do now and being who I am now. Brothers and sisters in Christ, I have a lot more to share to you about my life with God, including His messages in which He has given me since. Also, I witness some celestial miracles, visions and wonders from God, which I have lived with since. God has called me to be His witness since. In order to spread this Good News and to help many lost souls, He wanted me to preach here, and to create a website so that people from the four corners of the world could find beneficial and helpful information about God's Love and Mercy. This is the Mission of God that I have done since. My mission is God's inspiration. For without His inspiration, this prayer group will not come to life. I have not launched my site as yet, but I will do it very soon as God has directed me to do so. First, I need to speak with my spiritual director. I will inform you whenever I have already done so. AMEN!

Here is the most recent message of God, which I received on 24th May 2012, at the Adoration in Banneux. The Lord would like that I spread this message to you and in the world.

God the Father says,

"My dear people, I am your Father in Heaven; I have been watching you since the creation of this world. I have been with you ever since..."

God the Son says,

"Remain in My love and I will remain in you, for now and forever...Unite yourself to Me, and share this unity with others that you will be one, as I am one with My Father. Pray at all times, for having this unity. Love one another as I have loved you."

Sharing-Teaching

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

The Lord would like to send you this greeting: "Peace be with you ALL!"

Once again I am delighted as here we are again come together in the midst of the Lord to pray, to praise and to worship Him. May the Lord grant us today, the utmost blessing and healing according to His Will to every one of us present, today. Praise to Jesus! Amen! As usual, if you wish that I pray over you by laying my hands on you, do not hesitate to come to the centre at the end of this session, and our brothers and sisters here also could pray for you, all together. Amen!

Brothers and sisters in Christ, today I will talk what God has inspired me since....It is about the importance to listen God's Word and His Law and to put them into practice in our daily lives. Indeed, God's Law is the "Law of Love". In the Old Testament, Exodus 20: 1-17, the Law derives from His Ten Commandments, in which He handed them down to the hands of Moses on Mount Sinai (Exodus 19:1-2). In the New Testament, Jesus, the Son of the Living God and the only Saviour in the world, re-emphasised us about the Law of Love as well. In Matthew 22:36, one of the Pharisees asked Jesus, "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus answered him, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the most important commandment. The second most important commandment is like it: Love your neighbour as you love yourself. The whole Law of Moses and the teachings of the prophets depend on these commandments." Understandably, the Law of Moses and the teachings of the prophets mentioned here are all dependent on God's Ten Commandments, which described in the Old Testament. This Law is simplified by Jesus, that is the Law of LOVE that I aforementioned, and that this Law of LOVE is again given to us by Jesus, known as the New Commandment. In John 13:34, Jesus says, "And now I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." Brothers and sisters in Christ, why do you think that this Law of Love is essential to put into practice in our daily life? In other words, why has God called us since then to observe His Commandments of Love?

In John 13:35, Jesus says to his disciples, "If you have love for one another, then everyone will know that you are my disciples." It is clear, therefore, Jesus tells us here that He is God of Love, and if we have love for one another, we are accepting Jesus as our Saviour and Lord, and that we will love God the Father, as Jesus and His Father is ONE. When you accept Jesus, you know who God is and love Him, and that you know too that God the Almighty is your only Creator who lives with you and in you. When we live in the Lord, His Spirit is in us. God's Spirit knows who we are from the beginning we were formed in our mother's womb until the end of our lives. In other words, God knows our beginnings and our ends. He knows who we are better than we know ourselves. God's love is a gift to everyone. Each of us is dear to Him. Thus by living according to His Law of Love, we can have peace, joy, perseverance, strength to sustain suffering, humility, and all the virtues we need to be able to live meaningfully in this world. Whoever is committed to Him, strives to live in holiness as God is Holy. And you can see God, as you enter into this holiness. Your relationship with Him gets deeper, deeper than the deepest ocean when you seek him and his kingdom more and more each day in a contemplative prayer. Prayer, therefore is a wonderful gift from God, it is a "spiritual medicine" for inner-healing.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, do you know that God's Son, Jesus Christ; his suffering is a gift for you and me (?) He suffered inhumanly out of His love for us. Jesus Christ died on the cross for us all, for my and your redemption and for my and your salvation. Brothers and sisters in Christ, as you know...We are mere

human, human inclines to sin as we are all weak in all sorts of situations. God's plan for humanity is only ONE, to save us! Hence, God gives us the Ten Commandments, not to punish us but to show us how to live in holiness day-after-day, and thus we will have salvation.

Nowadays, unfortunately, many people ignore this insight. Yet, God is Merciful! Since God is Holy, He does not force any of us to opt His Law; it is our choice, whether we choose to listen and to try our best (with the grace of God) to practise to live according to His Commandments or, we choose to listen ourselves and to live according to our desire - human desire. Brothers and sisters in Christ, I let you now reflect about it and answer to God's call yourself. I invite you all to learn to pray (personally) in silence, that is, contemplative prayer. Only through prayer you can find God, and that you will find the way, the truth, and the life...Give your heart to God now - let God show you what you have to do in life, God is the one who controls our lives, He is the only Way, the Truth, and the Life, through Jesus Christ who is our only Saviour. If you surrender yourselves to Him, God promise you this Salvation in your life. In Exodus 19:5-6, God demands Moses to tell to the world this message: "Now, if you obey me and keep my covenant, you will be my own people. The whole earth is mine, but you will be my chosen people, a people dedicated to me alone, and you will serve me as priests." So, brothers and sisters in Christ, do you want to be God's sons and daughters who obey and keep His covenant? If you do, then God bless you and He will show you how to live, by trusting in His providence alone. Alleluia! May God's Name be praised and adore throughout the world, for He who reigns forever and ever, Amen!

In the next prayer meeting, on 30 September, I will continue giving the talk about the Ten Commandments. I shall talk in-depth the meaning of each Commandment of God. This then shall be in Part 2 of this talk.

I would like now to invite somebody to read the Ten Commandments of God in Exodus 20:1-17. Please read it slowly, and the rest of us listen to what the message is. Thank you!

I suggest you, my brothers and sisters in Christ, to re-read Exodus 20:1-17, if possible once a week. Meditate upon what God tells us to do according to His Law of Love. This is what we call... practising Spiritual Discipline, in order that we can grow in holiness. Let us ask God the grace to purify us from inside out...and to live up right with God, from now and forever. I invite you pray at all times, so that you will not fall into temptation. Speaking of prayer, Jesus did say the same to His disciples at Mount of Olives (see Luke 22:40; 22:46). Jesus wants us to pray for it is a powerful tool against evil. Temptation may come, at any time in our lives - thus prayer is the only solution. If we pray, we help ourselves to live healthy soul as prayer is the food for our soul. In Matthew 26:38, Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane where He was tremendously sorrow in the heart. When He saw His disciples were asleep, He said to them, '*Keep watch and pray that you will not fall into temptation.*" (Matthew 26:41) Brothers and sisters in Christ, I invite you to write these questions now, later at home, ask yourselves and answer them in your prayer to God. Here are the questions: how do I pray that can please God? How can I reach God in my prayer? How much time do I spare to keep watch and pray every day? Last but not least, how much do I love God? What should I do to please God? How can I serve God and His people? What do I know about God's Law of Love? When can I put the Law into practise?

I have some message of God to tell you and the whole world here. It is the message which I received on Friday, 15th June 2012. It is the feast day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I received it at the Adoration moment at Banneux.

"I am the God of Love and Mercy. Does anyone understand the meaning of My suffering? I give you My life, totally, so that you may have the Salvation, out of My Love for you. My people, do not turn away from Me, come to Me...for I am humble and gentle in heart. Come...drink this Living Water that comes forth from My heart. If you drink it you will not be thirsty any longer. My people, come to Me...near to My heart. Spend the time with Me and know that I AM your God, who loves you! Change your heart now and believe in this Good News! Give Me your heart, and I'll purify it. I'll fill it with all the goodness that brings you to life. I'll

give you the choice, because I Am the God of all holiness. Man shall not live by bread alone but by every Word that comes out from My mouth. Love your neighbours, and respect My Laws." "My Sacred Heart... pierced with a sword. It is a sign of My Love to the world - incessant love - infinity! Whoever receives this heart, will live...he or she will have Salvation."

"I Am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to My Father, except through Me. I speak the truth, and the truth will set you free. I Am the only Salvation, there is no others...Believe in Me and you will be saved. For this reason, I come to save you. I AM Jesus, the Son of the Living God, who died for you but I had resurrected, and I live amongst you now. Only by faith...you can see Me...Pray at all times, in silence, and have faith! Peace be with you all!"

Sharing - Teaching

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

How are you today?! I hope all of you are happy in the Lord!? Because the Lord, is our joy! Amen!

Before going further to the second part of my sharing and teaching about God's Law, let us again read and reflect the Scripture about the Ten Commandments in Exodus 20: 1-17. Is there anyone volunteer to read it out? Please read slowly and remind yourself all the Ten Commandments. (...) Basing on the Ten Commandments of God, I would like to ask now if anyone of you here remember what the Ten Commandments of God are. All right, can someone tell me what the First Commandment is? (RESPONSE)

Yes, the FIRST commandment is simply this: God is the only one God that we worship. In this first commandment, God calls us to love Him. Therefore, let us love God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind, as the Scripture says in Luke 10:27a, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind." Jesus replied, "Do this and you will live." (Luke 10:28). I'd like also to point out that God is a 'jealous' God. In Exodus 20:4-5, God says, "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God..." Brothers and sisters, the term 'jealous' here means God is alone the Almighty and our Creator; he is the Supreme God above all things on earth and in heaven - all belongs to Him and under His control. God does not tolerate any rivals or idols worship! For this reason, we, His creation must worship only Him. God is possessive of the worship and service belongs to Him. It is sin to worship anything other than God. Let me give you an example: we, human, we are too materialistic, and we spend much time in our favourite food, cars, drinking, beauty, etc. We forget who we should serve first, but our 'self'. People also can find no meaning in life, as they idolise what they desires rather than God, such as going to casino, passion in dancing in the night club, taking drugs, etc. These sins lead them to dead. People thought those are happiness...though if they are, they won't last. It is also sin when we desire, are envy or are jealous of someone because he/she has something that we do not have. It is different, therefore, the word "jealous" stated by God in Exodus 20:5. What God is jealous of belongs to Him; all worship and service is His, alone, and thus, the all worship and service is to be given to Him alone.

Since God is our Creator, He wants us to know that we are His creation and that He loves us so much. The evidence that God loves us is obvious: He saves us! He descended into the world to be with us, through Jesus Christ - His Son. Through His passion and the Cross He bears for us, He has redeemed our sins. Also, Jesus Chris's victorious Resurrection has delivered us from darkness; indeed it is the Great Mystery of the Divinity! God made us and He wants us to love Him in return. God is near us - close to us - in our heart. You can only know Him better if you spend time with Him in silence. If we surrender ourselves completely to Him, He will give us new life, a life that is full of joy... the joy that fills in our being in abundance! Alleluia! Brothers and sisters, never too late to receive this wonderful grace from Him...Taste and see, that the LORD our GOD is GOOD!

What is the SECOND Commandment?

The SECOND is this: We should not take the name of God in vain. It means that we should be on watch in our action, in our thoughts and in our words – do not blaspheme God. Do not perjure or do not make false witness about God in our sermon, teaching, sharing, etc, but let us be led by the Word of God in the Bible and that the Spirit of God leads us to do in His Truth.

On the other hand, we have to be aware of making a vow or swear something to people. For instance, when we want people to believe what we say, we may say, "I swear in the Bible, that I tell you the truth," or "I make a vow in the name of God that all I say is all true!" If we say this but what we did is not the fact...it is against God's commandment. Another example, many people use this expression almost every day, like "Oh My God! You are a brilliant boy!" "Oh my God! You such a bad boy!" Etc. We tend to deliberately misuse the Holy Name of God at any time - so be on watch! I do not judge here, but simply to give the examples, so that we can be careful to mention God's Holy name appropriately in any situation.

What is the THIRD Commandment?

The THIRD is this: We should keep the Sabbath day Holy. The Sabbath day here is the day of God, like Sunday Mass, and all other religious days such as Ash Wednesday, the Passion of the Lord, Easter, Christmas, Holy Souls Day, to name but a few. Once again, this commandment reflects God's love for humanity. He calls us to worship and serve Him during these Holy days. Since we are all God's creations, we are called to love Him. God also reminds us that we all dependent on His providence. For without His grace, what life means for us here in this world? Think... why do we exist, in other words, why are we here in the world? What is the reason we live here on earth? Is it for us, that is, for our 'self', or for God? The answer is clear...we were born and live in this world not for our 'self', but for God's Glory: to love Him, to worship Him, to work for Him, to build His Kingdom on earth, etc. God sees us all 'the same': we are the same children of Him, regardless of races, colours, creeds, positions, etc. For example, a prophet does not mean, the best child of God...and what about the apostles? Can we say, God favours them more than us? No, no matter what your position is, God treat us, the same - we are all his children and that He loves us equally.

What is the FOURTH Commandment?

The FOURTH is this: We should honour our parents and our seniors. In the commandment, God calls us to show respect and to love our parents, as well as the people who are older than us, for example, old and frail people. We should ask ourselves, do we obey this commandment? Do I respect my parents and love them every day? If so, how much love do we offer? If not, do we get reconciliation in order to attain peace? Do we respect our senior? For example, in Asia, I have perceived that there are more youngsters showing an act of respect to their parents and old people than in Europe. They let their parents stay with them, and look after them till the end. Many young people help old people, for instance, to let the seniors have their seats in a bus. Well, that is the act of charity that God wants us to do: to love as God loves and to serve as God serves. In John 13:34b Jesus says, "...As I have loved you, so you must love one another."

What is the FIFTH Commandment?

The FIFTH is this: We should not kill. God is a God of justice! In Isaiah 45:19b, the LORD says, "I am the LORD and I speak the truth; I make known what is right." From this Scripture, it make sense to us that since God is the one make known what is right or just - Justice is God. Since God is just, committing murder against someone is mortal sin. All acts of violence, either it can pertain to kill someone's body or mind, are against God. But God is Merciful, He capable to transform a murderer to be a saint, like the case of Saint Paul. Paul, before he was converted, he was known as Soul. He killed or massacred many people. God was not content with such hostility! Paul then became totally blind, but he repented to God and received His grace of Mercy. He was cured, and "Paul" is then God named him. He became the apostle of Christ and a saint. Brothers and sisters, God's Mercy is GREAT! And DIVINE! What do you think of this news in Belgium: do you think that killers like Mark Detroux and His wife must be condemned? If they ask for pardon, will you forgive though it is painful? Be Merciful, as God is merciful. We are all sinners! So forgive if they ask for mercy, and be in peace with one another. Judgement is not us, but God's!

What is the SIXTH Commandment?

The SIXTH is this: We should not commit adultery. In 1 Corinthians 6:18-20, the Scripture says, "Avoid immorality. Any other sin a man commits does not affect his body; but the man who is guilty of sexual immorality sins against his body. Don't you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and who was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourselves but to God; he bought you for a price. So use your bodies for God's glory." Hence in this commandment, God calls us to beware of evil tricks! Let us keep our mind and heart in the purity state and thus so, our body - as our body is the temple of

the Holy Spirit! In this modern era, you and me have heard and seen so many society problems, not only in Europe, but all over the world. Men and women no longer appreciate the Sacrament of Marriage, multiple marriages, homosexual marriages, scandal in the church, etc. I, see these...with sadness. I see the world is dead! Why can't the world see the LIGHT of CHRIST, which can help them do what just and holy is. These because of sins: selfishness, egoism, foolish pride, self-dependent, needing self-satisfaction; the sins make people blind... The LIGHT is there, but cannot see! Brothers and sisters, God wants us to live in chastity (purity). In Fatima, when I was there along with my family, we attended an English Holy Mass in the morning. The priest at the Mass said that "chastity" is the principle virtue, and that it is important to exercise the virtue. Even if a man looks at a woman's bare skin on the breast, he has committed sin already in his soul, and thus the woman too, for being dressed up immodestly, the priest stressed. Many souls go to hells, he said, only because of ignoring the virtue, "Chastity". At the Adoration at Fatima, God addressed to me a message for us and for the world. God spoke about the importance of being chastity. Let us pray for our world and anyone in our family who needs a prayer; ask God's grace for conversion from inside out.

What is the SEVENTH Commandment?

The SEVENTH is this: We should not steal. The LORD forbids the act of stealing our neighbours' properties. Today, there are many corruptions in the world. It can also happen in the church, everywhere! Stealing is sin as it against God's justice; I would like to draw your attention to two examples, see which of these two examples would you think is sin? One: a young man, unemployed, he disguised himself in black hood and clothes, he broke into your house and steal your jewelleries, and hundreds of money. Two: an old poor man, homeless, he broke into your house too, and he intends to get only money because he wants it to buy some food in order to be able to live. SO....Which one do you think is the act of stealing here, and which one is not? Why? My answer is this: God sees human heart, not our appearance. Before someone committing the act of stealing, God knows his/her attention is already...If the reason to steal is for being rich and for own pleasure, it is not just, such as the man in black, he takes it, yet he is capable to find job to be rich or for his own satisfaction. On the contrary, God's forgives this old poor man because he is hunger, homeless and needs food that he could not get if not by stealing. After all, of course, God also forgives the young man if he repents. Brothers and sisters, we must not steal in any form; instead we must respect peoples' properties.

What is the EIGHTH Commandment?

The EIGHTH is this: We should not bear false against our neighbours. This commandment means that we should not spread rumours about our neighbours' to others, whereby prejudicial situation can arise. God calls us to love our neighbours; to "love" here means that we avoid from prejudicing our family, friends, community, etc by dint of gossiping, telling rumours about other people. As a result, we hurt them. God calls us to be kind in our action, thoughts, and words. When there is harm or injury, we ask pardon, and they must learn to forgive. Thus this will create peace and strong friendships.

What is the NINETH Commandment?

The NINETH is this: For men, in particular, you should not covet your neighbour's wife. This commandment is relatively close to the Sixth Commandment: "Do not commit adultery." I should particularly emphasise on women too, though it does not mention in this Commandment, it means the same way that women should not covet married men. God calls us to put on watch that we remain entirely pure in our thoughts and desires.

Finally, what is the TENTH Commandment?

The TENTH is this: We should not covet our neighbours' goods. This commandment reminds us the Seventh Commandment of God: "*Do not steal*."In this commandment God calls us not to covet the property of others, and by having it dishonestly. Dishonest attitude here is sin as we take people's property by lying or by giving false info or reason so that we can have the property. Clearly, we do not respect our neighbours - what we do is not just.

Overall, brothers and sisters in Christ, I call you to observe the Ten Commandments of God, as much as possible, because they are the yardstick to lead us to live in the Truth and in Holiness. Being 'holy' means to

do what is good and just. Holiness is a gift from God - so ask for it. Love God first, put Him in the centre of your life, every day! Do you know that Heaven is for saints, but not for evils or unjust spirits? Therefore, if we want to go to heaven...then opt for God's Law of Love. God judge us according to the weight of love that we have in our heart for God and for His people (our neighbours). We live in God's love through serving the poor, the sick, and the unfortunate. God sees whatever we do in this world. Heaven is already lives in your heart, when you totally repent and believe the in the Good News and accept the LORD Jesus as your Saviour! God's Kingdom is in your heart, and in my heart, for the LORD our God reigns forever and ever! Amen!
